## **Top Tips** for Safeguarding **the** future:



### **Recycle your old toner cartridges**

All materials used in Toshiba MFP equipment can be recycled and made into new products such as jewellery and copper wiring. Recycling these products often uses less energy and makes better use of our material resources. It also leaves more “virgin” materials in the ground for future generations.

Toner particles are reused to help in the production of paint or as a colouring agent in aggregates whilst the plastic toner bottles are either used again or sent off to make plastic products such as garden furniture.

Cardboard used in packaging or for transporting the waste toner bottles is sent off to be reused and can end up as egg cartons or animal bedding.

The Toshiba range of products are energy star compliant - automatically switching into a “sleep” mode when not being used and/or reducing the amount of power used when in “standby” mode.



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# Recycling Toner FAQs



**Q. Does any of the waste end up in landfill?**

**A.** No. All materials that are returned are recycled and re-used.

**Q. Do consumables form part of the WEEE directive?**

**A.** No. WEEE refers to Electric and Electronic Equipment.

**Q. What can I put in the box?**

**A.** The service is designed for the return and recycling of waste toner, empty toner bottles and empty developer bottles.

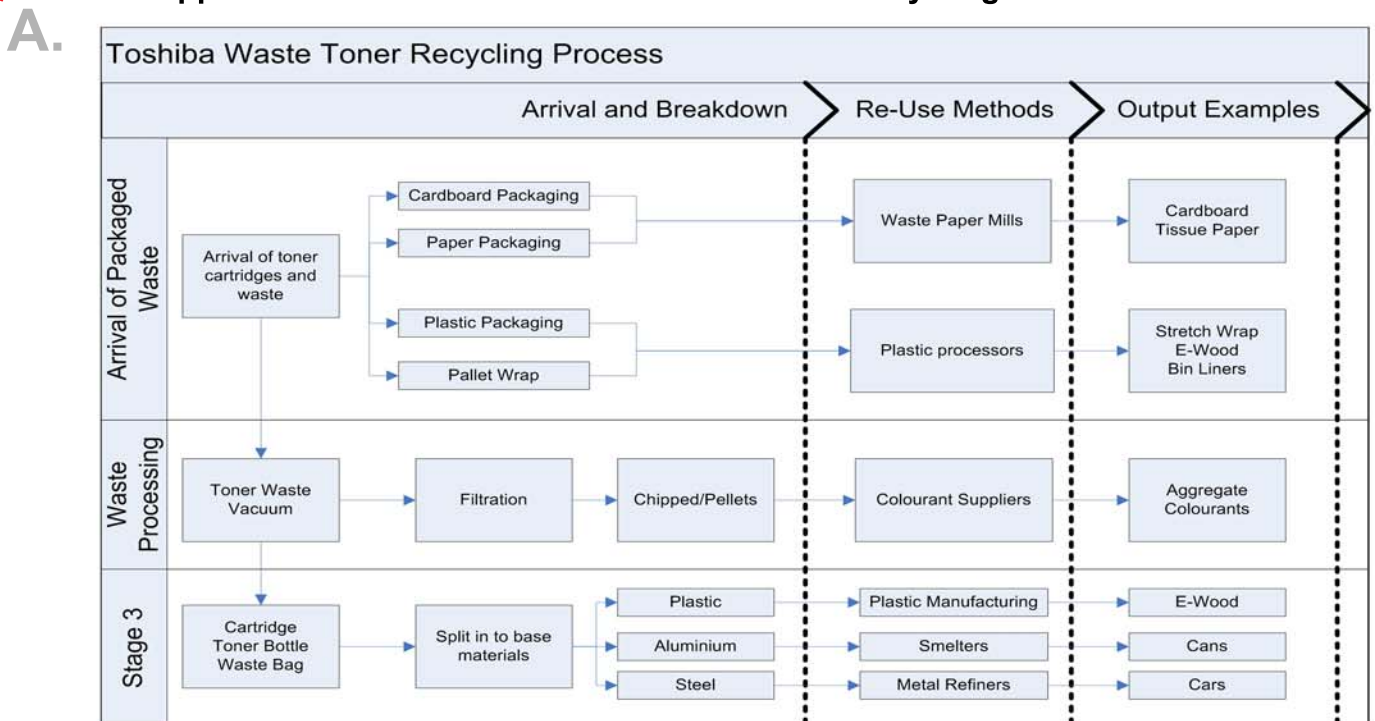
**Q. How much can I put in the box?**

**A.** The box should be full and the lid should be able to close before requesting the collection. Whilst the ECO Box should not be overfilled, part-filled boxes increase the carbon footprint associated with transportation.

**Q. Is the collection of waste toner a legal requirement?**

**A.** No. Toshiba subsidise this service to reduce the impact on the environment compared to the landfill alternative.

**Q. What happens to the waste once it has arrived at the recycling centre?**
